Alliteration is the repetition of initial consonant sounds in two or more neighbouring words.

Here are some examples of alliteration:

Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers

The wild winds of winter

Careless cars cutting corners create confusion

Sally sells seashells by the seashore

Round the rugged rock the ragged rascal ran

Big bees buzz by Bob's bushes

Beautiful blue butterflies fluttered by Belinda
